#### **GREETINGS**

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Turners Falls Fire District legally qualified to vote in said District Meeting, to meet at the **Turners Falls High School Theater**, 220 **Turnpike Road**, Montague on <u>Tuesday</u>, April 16, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. then and there to transact the following business:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the District will vote to accept the reports of the District Officers as published and further vote to hear and accept the reports of any committee appointed by the Moderator and take any relative action thereon, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the District will vote to authorize its Treasurer, with the approval of the Prudential Committee and Water Commissioners to borrow monies from time to time in anticipation of revenue or water rates for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019 in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and issue a note or notes therefore, payable one (1) year within and renew any note or notes as may be given for a period of less than one (1) year, in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 17, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the District will vote to require a bond from a fidelity company for its Treasurer, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020 for the purpose of **operating said District** and such amounts as are requested and proposed in the Annual Report for such operational purposes, or take any action relative thereto.

Amount Requested....\$ 3,021,457.14

ARTICLE 5. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the purpose of **driveway repairs** at **the Fire Station**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

### Amount Requested......\$ 40,000

ARTICLE 6. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the purpose of paying separation pay for 1/3 of unused sick leave to the retiring Deputy Fire Chief or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 19,000

ARTICLE 7. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the purpose of paying unused vacation pay to the retiring Deputy Fire Chief or take any action relative thereto.

### Amount Requested......\$ 12,500

ARTICLE 8. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to provide additional funds for the **exhaust system upgrade** at the **Fire Department**, or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 25,500

ARTICLE 9. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the **Stabilization Fund**, or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 25,000

ARTICLE 10 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the **Stabilization Fund** for the **future purchase of vehicles** for the **Fire Department**, or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 50,000

ARTICLE 11. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to provide additional funds for the **Other Post Employments Benefits (OPEB) Trust Fund** obligation or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 10,000

ARTICLE 12. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for **future water main replacements or repairs** including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

## Amount Requested......\$ 50,000

ARTICLE 13. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money for the purpose of **upgrades** to the **water metering system**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 20,000

ARTICLE 14. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to purchase a **mowing tractor** for the **Water Department**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 11,500

ARTICLE 15. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide any sum or sums of money to purchase an **equipment trailer** for the **Water Department**, including any incidental or related costs, or take any action relative thereto.

# Amount Requested......\$ 8,000

ARTICLE 16. To see if the District will vote, in accordance with the provisions of G.L. c. 44, §53E1/2, and authorized by Chapter 170 Section 1 of the Acts of 2015, to establish the spending limit for the revolving fund for Land Management for Fiscal Year 2020 at \$5,000, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 17. To see if the District will vote to authorize the Board of Assessors to use any sum or sums of money from available unappropriated funds for the purpose of reducing District Taxes for the fiscal year July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 18. To see if the District will vote to authorize the Prudential Committee and/or the Water Commissioners to **apply for and accept grants** from the Federal Government, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts or any other source and to expend the same for purposes received without further appropriation, or take any action relative thereto.

And you are hereby directed to notify the inhabitants of the Turners Falls Fire District to meet in the <u>Turners Falls Fire District Offices</u>, 226 Millers Falls Road, <u>Turners Falls on Tuesday</u>, <u>April 23</u>, 2019 at 12:00 O'clock, noon until 7:00 O'clock in the afternoon, then and there to vote for the following officers of the Turners Falls Fire District, viz.: one PRUDENTIAL COMMITTEE member for three (3) years, one PRUDENTIAL COMMITTEE member for one (1) year, and one WATER COMMISSIONER for three (3) years.

And you are hereby directed to serve this Warrant by causing attested copies thereof to be posted in not less than five (5) public places within the District, at least seven (7) days before the time of said meeting.

Whereof fail not, and make due the return of the Warrant to the Prudential Committee and Water Commissioners at time of said meeting.
